What We Offer



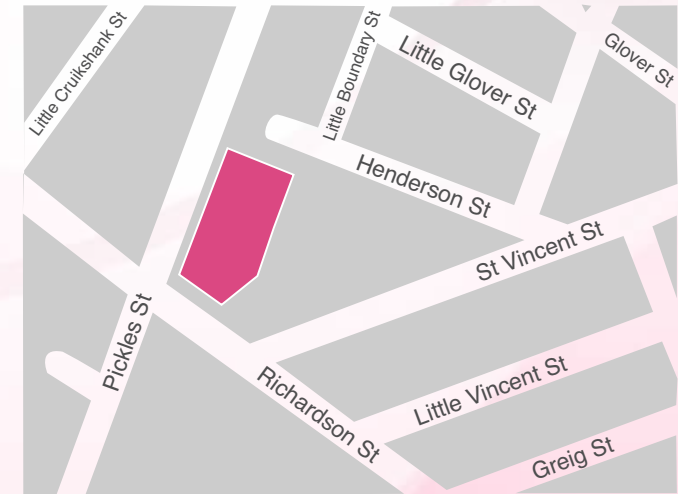
SKYS Young Parents program provides a supportive environment for young parents and their children.
